

Instructions for self-study

Course's linear organisation of study:

For the students to finish the course, four weeks of study will be needed. Each week, new topics with lessons taught by different professors will be available to the enrolled students. For the students, to proceed to the next week, all the obligations and quizzes of the previous one must be successfully completed.

Obligations and time frames of the course:

For the whole course, five weeks of studying will be needed. In the first four weeks, all the study materials should be read and tested by successfully completing the course's quizzes, while in the fifth week, individual assignments should be done and submitted for evaluation.

Weekly obligations:

During each week, four to five topics will be available. In each subject, all the materials should be studied by watching a video, checking a presentation prepared by a professor, and reading corresponding reading material. To finish one topic and be allowed to continue to the next one, a quiz should be completed successfully. By successfully completing a quiz, the corresponding lesson will be marked as finished.

Approach to quizzes:

There are five single choice questions in each quiz. For a student to be successful, at least four questions must be correctly answered. The number of approaches to a quiz is limited to a maximum of 5. In case, a participant does not complete one of the course's quizzes successfully, completion of the whole course is not possible anymore. For each successfully completed quiz, a certificate of completion will be issued that will be available in participants' user profile.

Forum and possibilities of communication with enrolees and professors involved in the course:

In the course, there is a forum in which all the students, as well as all the professors, can ask questions, answer questions, comment on the course's topics, etc.
